# PARTS LIST





#### **PRE-INSTALLED PARTS**



#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Find a clean, level place to begin the assembly of your Basketball Game. We recommend that two adults work together to assemble this basketball game.
- Remove all the parts from the box and verify that you have all of the listed parts as shown on the Parts list pages. Carefully cut or tear the four corners of the box so that the bottom of the box can be used as your work surface.

- 3. Attach the Tubes 2 (#2) to the Tube 3 and Tube 4 (#3 and #4) using the spring lock mechanism (pre-installed) as shown in FIG. 1.
- 4. Attach the Tubes 7 (#7) to the Tubes 8 (#8) using the spring lock mechanism (pre-installed) as shown in FIG. 2.



6. Attach the Tubes - 12 (#12) to the Tube - 9, Tube - 10 and Tube - 11 (#9, #10 and #11) using the spring lock mechanism (pre-installed) as shown in FIG. 4.



- 7. Attach the Tube 5 and Tube 6 (#5 and #6) to Tube 3 and Tube - 4 (#3 and #4) using Bolts (#30), Washers (#26) and Nuts (#32), and then attach the Tube - 5 and Tube - 6 (#5 and #6) to the Tubes - 8 (#8) and Tube - 15 (#15) using Bolts (#31), Washers (#26) and Nuts (#32) as shown in FIG. 5A & 5B.
- 8. Attach the Tubes 7 and Tubes 8 (#7 and #8) to the Tubes 2 (#2) using Bolts (#31), Washers (#26) and Nuts (#32) as shown in FIG. 5C, repeat this step for other side.

Note: Make sure the spring lock mechanism is face down.



10. Insert the Tubes - 1 (#1) to the Tubes - 2 (#2) as shown in FIG. 7.





11. Insert the Tubes - 14 (#14) to the Tubes - 13 (#13) as shown in FIG. 8.

12. Attach the Tubes (#9, #10, #11, #12) to Tube - 14 (#14) and Tube - 8 (#8) using Bolts (#29), Washers (#26), Spacers (#40), Locking Pins (#38) and Nuts (#32) as shown in FIG. 9A & 9B.



Attach the Rims (#21) and Rim Support Plates (#22) to the Backboard (#25) using the Bolts (#27), Washers (#26) and Nuts (#32). Then attach the Paddle Sensors (#19) to the Backboard (#25) using the Bolts (#27), Washers (#20 & #26) and Nuts (#32). Ensure that washers are used on both sides of the backboard as shown in FIG. 10.



- 14. Attach the Electronic Scorer Face Plate (#35) to the front of the Backboard and connect with the Electronic Scorer (#18) using Bolts (#33) as shown in FIG. 11.
- 15. Install the Net (#24) to the Rim (#21) as shown in FIG. 11A and 11B.



- 16. Slide elastic straps and sleeve of Ball Return Net (#39) onto Top Tubes 1 (#1) as shown in FIG. 12A & 12B.
- 17. Slide the Tube 15 (#15) in front of the Ball Return Net (#39) and attach it to the Tube 14 (#14) using Bolts (#37), Washers (#26) and Nuts (#32) as shown in FIG. 12C.



- With the help of another adult, Attach the Backboard (#25) to the Tubes - 1 (#1) using Bolts (#34), Washers (#20 & #26) and Nuts (#32) as shown in FIG. 13A. At each bottom hole of the backboard, attach the ramp tabs of Ball Return Net (#39) using Bolts (#34), Washers (#20 & #26), and Nuts (#32) as shown in FIG. 13B.
- 19. Insert the Locking Pins (#38) to the Tube 8 (#8) as shown in FIG. 13C.





20. Connect the Sensor Wire of Paddle Sensor (#19) to the Electronic Scorer (#18) as shown in FIG. 14.



- Folding the basketball game First remove the Locking Pins (#38).See FIG. 15A. Then attach the Safety Straps (#P6) together to prevent the sides from falling. Repeat for the other side. See FIG. 15B.
- 22. To unfold the basketball game First release the Safety Straps (#P6). Then pull the handle and the bottom of the tube 13 (#13) , and slowly lower the table to the floor.

### **ELECTRONIC SCORER OPERATION**

#### **Battery Installation**

Battery Box: Unscrew the bolt using a screwdriver and open the battery box. Insert <u>3 "AA"</u> batteries (not included) in the order of polarity as shown on the inside cover. Then close the cover using a screwdriver. Turn the power ON using the ON/OFF switch.

#### **Reminding:**

- a. Batteries must be installed according to the correct polarization (+ and -) required.
- b. Please clean the battery contacts and also those of the device prior to battery installation.
- c. If the game will not be used for a long period of time, we recommend that the batteries should be removed.



#### How to play?

- 1. While game is in Sleep Mode, if a basketball is scored, the game will turn back on and the score board will begin the 5 sec. countdown.
- 2. After finishing the game, Turn OFF the scorer by using the ON/OFF switch. NOTE: The scoreboard will turn off after 5 minutes of inactivity; however, we recommend turning the ON/OFF switch to OFF when the game will not be used for an extended period of time.

#### **WARNING**:

- 1) Requires 3 "AA" batteries (not included).
- 2) Do not mix old and new batteries.
- 3) Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
